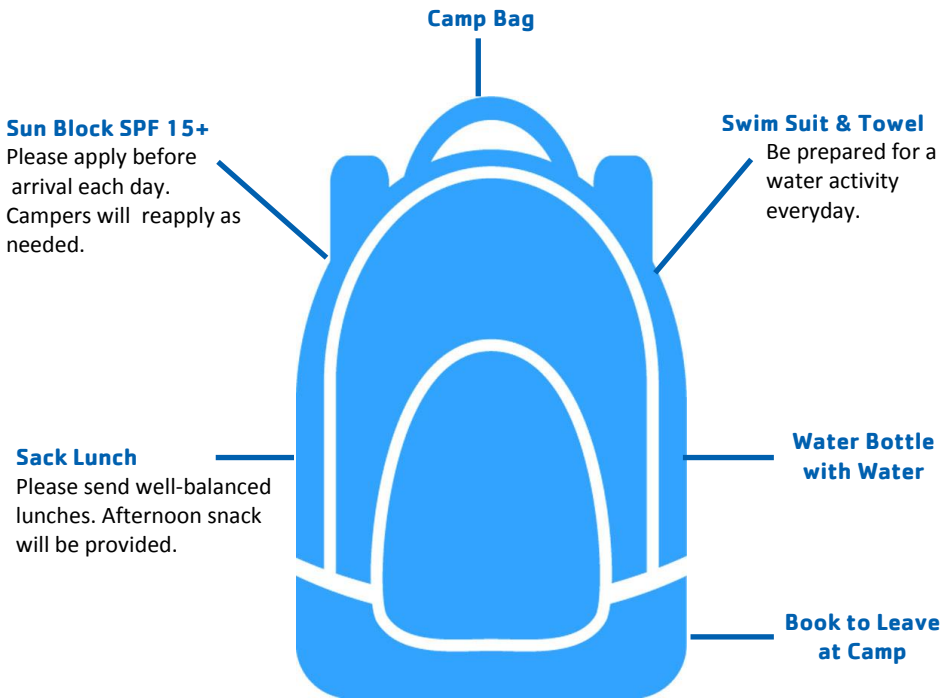
## Drop Off & Pick Up Times

Actual camp will run from 9am to 4pm each day. The camp site will be open at 7:45am each day and closed at 4:25pm to help accommodate parents working hours. If parents need to drop off earlier than 7:45 and picked up later than 4:25, campers will need to be scheduled for before and after camp care at the Children's School-Fee \$2.50 before-\$2.50 after. The Children's School is open at 6:15am and closes at 6pm. Breakfast will only be served to the children who arrive at the Children's School by 7:35. Children will be transported to camp at 7:45 daily. **We encourage all campers to arrive by 9am each morning to join in the full day of activities planned.**

\*If a camper is not picked up by 4:25pm, they will be transported to the Children's School and after camp fees will be assessed.
