## Facility Use Policy

All scheduled activities for the pool, basketball courts and weight room are subject to change. Call for availability.

The Health and Wellness Center and Weight Room facilities are available for those 14 and older.

The track that circles above the track is open to all members. However children 6<sup>th</sup> grade and younger must be accompanied by an adult 18 or older.

The Sauna and Hot Tub is open to members 18 and older.

Mercer County Family YMCA was constructed to high health and safety standards. The Y is not responsible for accidents and does not provide medical insurance for members or participants. Each person agrees to hold the Y harmless for any injury that occurs.

You must provide your own lock and take it home daily. We recommend you always lock your locker. The Y is not responsible for lost or stolen articles.

In relation to the goals and philosophy of the Y, tobacco use and smoking are not prohibited on Y property or at Y Events.

When not participating in a program or checked in with the babysitter, children under the age of 6 must be under the direct supervision of an adult. To maintain cleanliness standards, food and drink are allowed only in designated areas.

Appropriate gym attire, including clean gym shoes, is required when using this facility.

As members, we can all share the pride and responsibilities of ownership of our Y. Please report anything that is broken or if you witness and vandalism or inappropriate behavior.

All use of the facility must be in harmony with the YMCA Mission: To put Christian principles into practice through programs that promote a healthy spirit, mind and body for all.



## Registration Policy

Payment is due upon registration.

Registration before the session is strongly encouraged. Some programs require paid pre-registration.

You may register for open classes in person anytime the Y is open.

Paid Registration guarantees a space in the class. You may also register by telephone using your credit card or debit card (VISA and MasterCard).

On-going classes such as swim lessons and fitness classes require registration every 5 weeks.

Classes may be cancelled if class enrollments do not meet minimum requirements.

Credit will be given only to participants who missed class due to a documented illness. Classes missed due to vacations or family scheduled conflicts are not eligible for a credit or refund.

If a class is cancelled a credit to another class will be made.
